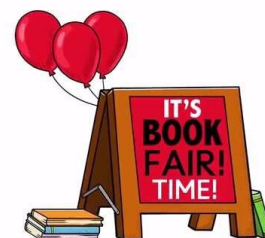

Habit 5 : Seek First to Understand, Then to Be Understood
"Before I can walk in another's shoes, I must first remove my own."

It is a tendency of people to want to swoop out of the sky like Superman & solve everyone's problems before we even understand what the problem is. We simply don't listen. The key to communication & having power & influence with people can be summed up in one sentence: "Seek first to understand, then to be understood." Listen first, talk second. Everyone must be buzzed into the school before entering



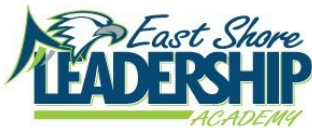
