If your child is sick, keep them home.

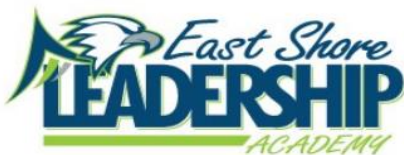

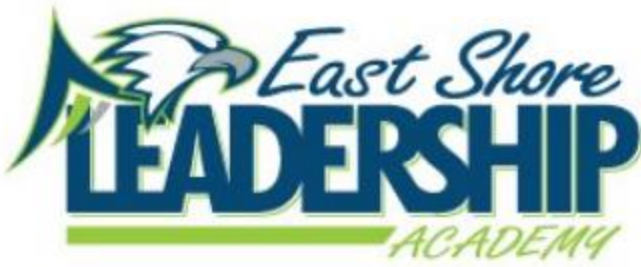
